



Call for a Tenure Track Faculty Research Position in Urban Planning

The Department of Environment, Planning & Sustainability, Bar-Ilan University is accepting applications for a full-time, tenure-track position in Urban Planning to commence in October 2025. The department is part of the Faculty of Social Sciences and has a long-standing commitment to excellence in research, teaching, and student supervision both in its undergraduate and graduate degree programs. The department's faculty members specialize and lead programs in the fields of Urban Geography and Planning, Earth Sciences, and Environmental Studies.

The department is seeking a social scientist with core expertise in urban planning. Applicants should have a sound research background in one or more of the following fields: urban and regional planning, urban studies/geography, urban economics, urban sociology, and urban policy. The position includes full-time teaching, supervision of graduate students, and the development of an independent research agenda based on competitive grants.

Relevant candidates are invited to apply for a tenure-track research position at the level of lecturer/senior lecturer. Priority will be given to candidates applying novel, cutting-edge critical research who are proficient in the utilization of advanced geographical information tools.

The successful applicant must have completed a post-doctoral fellowship, preferably abroad, and possess a proven record of excellence in research and a sound teaching experience. Given its small size, the department is especially interested in candidates who are team-players and are likely to become openly communicative faculty members. The accepted candidate must become fluent in Hebrew at a teaching level after two years at the latest.
